Replacement Component Installation Instructions

STEP 1

SPOTTER GLASS REPLACEMENT (part # 9010)

Existing spotter glass removal.

Make sure you have the required tools:

- no special tools are required.

Approximate installation time: 5 minutes.

WARNING: Take care when dealing with all glass products, especially broken glass.

1. Push in the top edge of the spotter glass while lifting the bottom edge with your thumb. This action will not remove the spotter glass, but begins to release it from the mechanism behind.

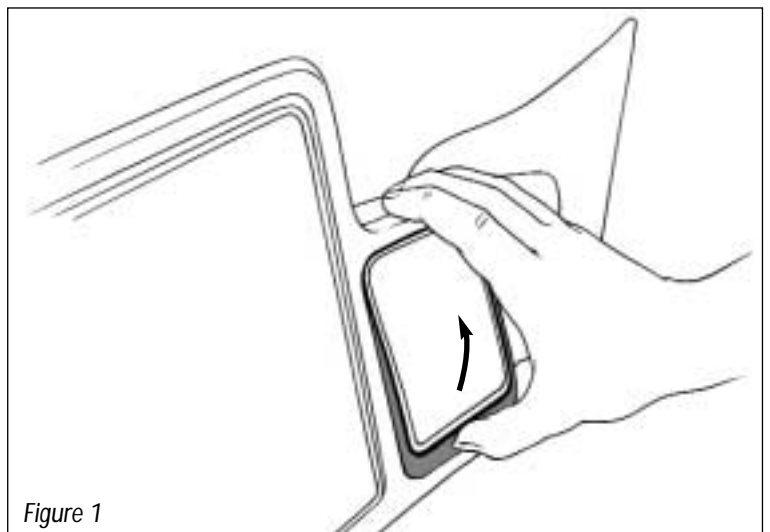

2. Then push in the spotter glass base, exposing the top edge of the spotter glass.
(see Figure 2 opposite)

To free the spotter glass, use a finger to push the motor mechanism back in (the motor mechanism is behind the spotter glass), releasing the spotter glass from the retaining clip behind.
(see Figure 2b)

This should free the spotter glass completely.

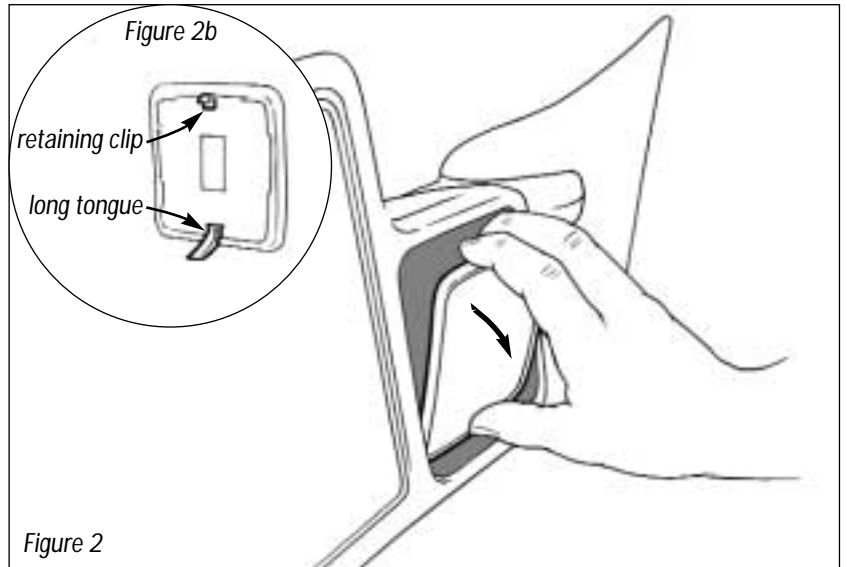

3. To refit spotter glass, the long tongue must be at the bottom. Position the replacement spotter glass centrally over the motor mechanism.
(see Figure 3 opposite)

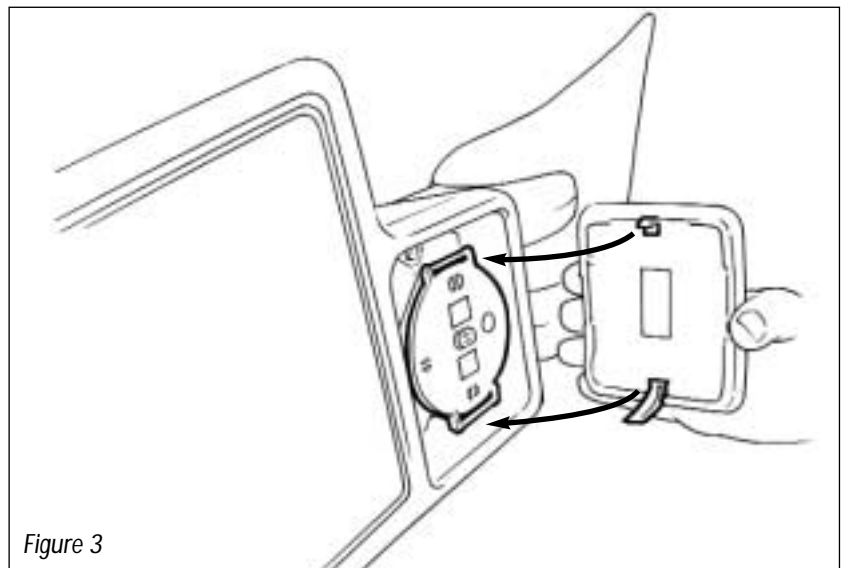

4. Press the spotter glass onto the motor mechanism, and check for correct fit and movement.
